Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Jayasankaran said :

But there are two skills that are very important – people skills and thinking skills. Peter Drucker said that the essence of management is the management of people. In a networked knowledge society, a good manager operates on the strengths of people, making their weaknesses irrelevant. And hence,

- Reflect on your internal capabilities –that which gives you joy and happiness.
- Develop right kind of attitudes; positive attitudes. The mind is powerful. Handle and suppress a negative thought.
- Inculcate right kind of values. Being a manager with competence is good. But what is more important is being a leader with Integrity.
- Be a life-long learner
